Aging and Independent Living Update

Ms. Susan Taylor gave an update on the Aging Department. She shared that the Older Adult Homes Modification Project has given their qualified Responses and we only had one (1) to qualify. Still looking for the Handy worker modifier for the grant. RFP Home Modifier "Handy-worker" 0 qualified responses.

Ms. Susan Taylor stated that the SHIP open enrollments continued through December 7, 2021. One (1) on prescription drug coverage saved over \$81K.

We now have six (6) senior centers back open for congregated meals, along with delivery and drive through continuing.

CEDS Update/Resolution

Kasey gave an update to the board on the yearly update on CEDS, this is the last yearly update in the cycle, we will be doing a (5) five-year update 2022. The updates are tourism, ongoing projects, evaluation, and government performance.

We need a resolution accepting the CEDS update contingent on adding the GPRA data when available. Judge Randy Dial made the motion to accept the resolution. Judge Gary Robertson offered a second. Motion carried.

Executive Director Report

Mr. Waylon Wright updated the board about CDBG Water and Recreation Trails Grants will be opening this Spring, so if you have any project you want to be considered for application let Mr. Wright know as soon as you can.

RLF update 1.340 M CARES Act all has been loaned but 80, 000.00, so if you know a business that needs working capital please send them our way.

The agency has an older fund from 1988-89, we have loaned out of multi times out of. We have been working on getting it defederalized, which the board approved a resolution to make that happen in the Spring. We have made our updates to the resolution to get it finalized, that has been done as of today. Between the two groups of funds we have 31 loans out.

Mr. Wright updated the board CDBG as waiting on DLG to release funds for the COVID Utility Assistant Program, as soon as those funds are released the agency will be start getting that money out the door.

State Revolving Infrastructure Authority have called for all projects to be in by December 15, 2021.

Mayor Robert Lawson mentioned that Brenda Allen mayor of Campbellsville has resigned and Diane Ford-Benningfield has taken her place.
