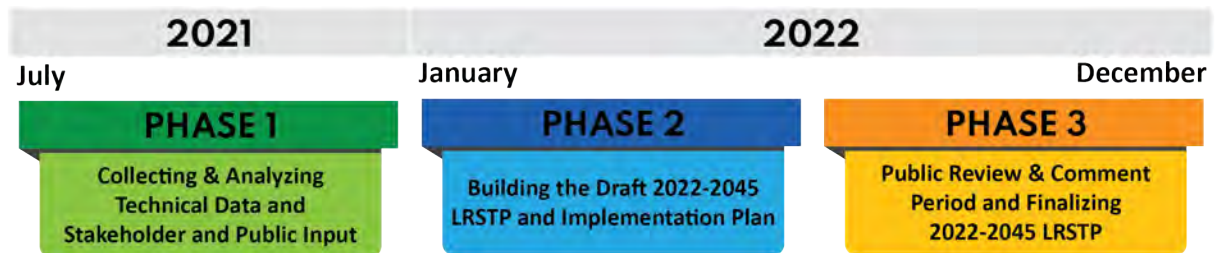

We will offer several opportunities to hear public and stakeholder input throughout the planning process to help shape the direction of statewide transportation planning for the next 25 years.

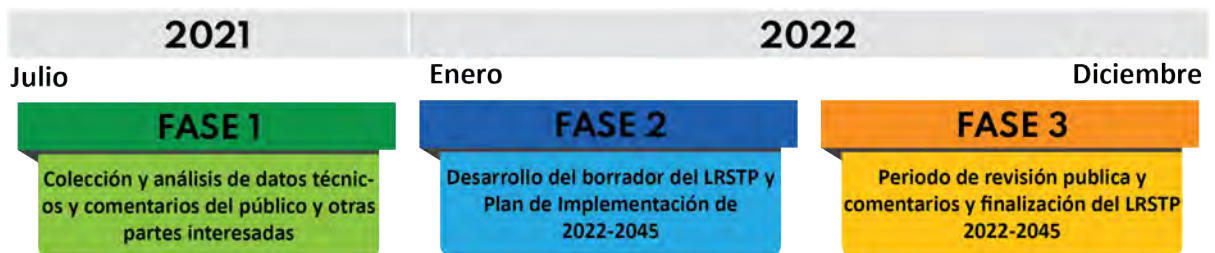
