

Lake Cumberland ADD Regional Transportation Committee
Thursday, March 3, 2022 @ 12:00 Central Time
Meeting Minutes

Judge Executive John Phelps, Vice-Chairman called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. in-person as well as via Zoom conference with 25 persons attending. Judge Phelps welcomed everyone then turned the meeting over to Mr. Kevin Young,

Mr. Young gave project status updates for Green and Taylor Counties. Mr. Young also discussed projects in the construction phase as well as project completion dates. With no questions or comments Judge Phelps turned the meeting over to Mr. James Jones, Department of Highways District 8.

Mr. Jones gave project status updates for Adair, Casey, Clinton, Cumberland, McCreary, Pulaski, Russell, and Wayne Counties. Mr. Dick also discussed Future Lettings (Proposed Dates), Projects in Design Status, Ongoing Construction Status, FD05 (MP) Resurfacing Project, HSIP (Highway Safety Improvement Program) – Project (Federal funding safety projects) as well as projects completed.

Judge Phelps thanked Mr. Young and Mr. Jones then turned the meeting over to Mr. Ian Cole who introduced himself as the new LCADD Transportation Planner. Mr. Cole then started the LCADD RTC Membership Review/Election. Mr. Cole stated that there was a nomination turned in by Adair County Judge-Executive Gail Cowan. With the EMS Representative being vacant, Judge Cowan nominated Mr. Darryl Flatt to fill that position. Judge Randy Dial made a motion to cease nominations for that position. Seconded by Judge Jimmie Greene. All in Favor. Motion Carried. Judge John Frank then made a motion to accept Mr. Darryl Flatt to represent the EMS as a 2022 Fiscal Year Voting Member. Seconded by Judge Gary Robertson. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Mr. Cole also stated that Mr. Waylon Wright was removing himself as a Voting Member. Judge John Frank nominated Mrs. Fara Miniard to fill Mr. Wrights position as representative of the Economic and Industrial Development Organizations. Judge Gary Robertson made a motion to cease nominations for that position. Seconded by Judge Jimmie Greene. All in Favor. Motion Carried. Judge John Frank made a motion to accept Mrs. Fara Miniard to represent the Economic and Industrial Development Organizations as a 2022 Fiscal Year Voting Member. Seconded by Judge Gary Robertson. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Mr. Cole went on to say that there were more vacant positions to be filled and asked if anyone had someone they wanted to nominate to fill the positions needed. Judge Gary Robertson nominated Mrs. Amy Shirley to represent public safety agencies. Judge Jimmie Greene made a motion for nominations to cease for that position. Seconded by Judge Randy Dial. All in Favor. Motion Carried. Judge Gary Robertson made a motion to accept Mrs. Amy Shirley to represent the public safety agencies as a 2022 Fiscal Year Voting Member. Seconded by Judge John Frank. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Judge Randy Dial nominated Mr. Chad Weddle to represent county law enforcement. Judge Gary Robertson made a motion to cease nominations for that position. Seconded by Judge John Frank. All in Favor. Motion Carried. Judge Randy Dial made a motion to accept Mr. Chad Weddle to represent county law enforcement as a 2022 Fiscal Year Voting Member. Seconded by Judge John Frank. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Other vacant position for the 2022 Fiscal Year Voting Members list are as follows: A representative of highway/public works, representative of the freight movers and a representative of state law enforcement. With there being no other nominees the transportation committee agreed to revisit these vacant positions at the June 2022 Regional Transportation Committee Meeting.

Next Mr. Cole gave a brief overview of the new LCADD RTC Member Guide then introduced Mr. Don Franklin, LCADD Disaster Recovery Coordinator to discuss the Hazard Mitigation Plan Update as well as the CEDS SWOT Analysis.




In other business Mr. Cole let everyone know that there will be a Kentucky Transportation Center County Elected Officials Training Incentive Program that will be hosted by the Kentucky Transportation Center every second Wednesday of each month at 9 am EST. Webinar Wednesdays, free one-hour webinar related to Leadership and Transportation. 
