Lake Cumberland ADD Regional Transportation Committee Thursday, March 3, 2022 @ 12:00 Central Time Meeting Minutes

With there being no other nominees the transportation committee agreed to revisit these vacant positions at the June 2022 Regional Transportation Committee Meeting.

Next Mr. Cole gave a brief overview of the new LCADD RTC Member Guide then introduced Mr. Don Franklin, LCADD Disaster Recovery Coordinator to discuss the Hazard Mitigation Plan Update as well as the CEDS SWOT Analysis.
