

Lake Cumberland ADD Regional Transportation Committee
Thursday, June 2, 2022 @ 12:00 Central Time
Meeting Minutes

Mayor Pam Hoots, Chairperson called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. in-person as well as via Zoom conference with 25 persons attending. Mayor Hoots welcomed everyone then turned then asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the March 3, 2022 meeting. Motion to approve the minutes was made by Judge Gary Robertson. Seconded by Mayor Ford-Benningfield. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

The next item on the agenda was LCADD RTC Membership Review/Election. Mayor Hoots stated that Mr. Daryl Flatt from Adair County will make a recommendation to the committee. Mr. Flatt then recommended Mrs. Cindy Alexander with the Lake Cumberland CDL School for the Freight Movers position. Mayor Diane Ford-Benningfield made a motion to put Cindy Alexander in the Freight Movers position. Seconded by Judge John Phelps. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Mayor Hoots then turned the Meeting over to Mr. Ian Cole, LCADD Transportation Planner. Mr. Cole presented a PowerPoint that he made for the HB242, 2022 biennial highway construction plan district 4/8 projects with amendments and additions in HB 490 for district 8 and district 4.

Mr. Cole then turned the meeting over to Mr. Kevin Young, Department of Highways District 4. Mr. Young gave project status updates for Green and Taylor Counties. Mr. Young also discussed projects in the construction phase as well as project completion dates. Questions/comments were asked for. Mayor Diane Ford-Benningfield ask questions with concerns about the new bypass in Campbellsville. Mr. Brad Bottom with KYTC answered her questions and commented that he would like to follow up with her and discuss the concerns of the bypass in further detail. With no other questions or comments Mr. Cole turned the meeting over to Mr. Jeff Dick, Department of Highways District 8.

Mr. Dick gave project status updates for Adair, Casey, Clinton, Cumberland, McCreary, Pulaski, Russell, and Wayne Counties. Mr. Dick also discussed Future Lettings (Proposed Dates), Projects in Design Status, Ongoing Construction Status, FD05 (MP) Resurfacing Project, HSIP (Highway Safety Improvement Program) – Project (Federal funding safety projects) as well as projects completed.

Mr. Cole thanked Mr. Young and Mr. Dick then turned the meeting over to Mr. Craig Caudill, Branch Manager Office of Rural Secondary Roads. Mr. Caudill gave a very informative PowerPoint presentation on things such as: Revenue Share Breakdowns, Motor Fuels Tax Receipts, Statutory Revenue Sharing, Emergency Funding, Flex Funding FY 23 Projection, how to apply for Flex Funding, etc.

In Other Business Mr. Cole stated that this month the Major Freight Movers Inventory will be due and that he would be contacting the counties and cities to see if there have been any new warehouses, new businesses or any changes that may have been made. Mr. Cole also gave a deadline date of September 2022 for the Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) State Streets for All grant program as well as an update on the TAP Grant information.

With no questions or comments Mayor Hoots ask for a motion to adjourn. Motion to adjourn at 1:00 p.m. was made by Judge John Phelps. Second by Judge Gary Robertson. All in Favor. Motion Carried.


