Meeting Minutes

Chairman Kenneth Catron, Mayor City of Monticello called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. in-person as well as via Zoom conference with 30 persons attending. Chairman Catron welcomed everyone then turned then asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the March 2, 2023 meeting. Motion to approve the minutes was made by Judge Todd. Seconded by Judge Marcum. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Chairman Catron then turned the meeting over to Mr. Kevin Young, Department of Highways District 4. Mr. Young gave project status updates for Green and Taylor Counties. Mr. Young also discussed projects in the construction phase as well as project completion dates. With no questions or comments Chairman Catron thanked Mr. Young then turned the meeting over to Ms. Mallory Frye, Department of Highways District 8.

Ms. Frye gave project status updates for Adair, Casey, Clinton, Cumberland, McCreary, Pulaski, Russell, and Wayne Counties. Mr. Dick also discussed Future Lettings (Proposed Dates), Projects in Design Status, Ongoing Construction Status, FD05 (MP) Resurfacing Project, HSIP (Highway Safety Improvement Program) – Project (Federal funding safety projects) as well as projects completed.

Chairman Catron introduced the Guest Speaker, Mr. Craig Caudill, Branch Manager with the Office of Rural Secondary Roads. Mr. Caudill gave a very informative PowerPoint presentation explaining the Funding Breakdown-Emergency Funds of Rural Secondary, County Road Aid, and Municipal Road Aid, as well as Rural Secondary Funding Breakdown of Maintenance & Traffic, Yearly stipend to each County Judge-Executive, Rural Secondary Lettings, and Flex Funding which are funds set aside from the Rural Secondary apportionment to help counties in their resurfacing needs. These funds are to solely used for repairs and resurfacing the existing asphalt surface. With over 40,000 county road miles we recognize the need for assistance. At the beginning of the year, District personnel will communicate with each county as to the amount of Flex Funds the county will be allocated for the upcoming fiscal year. Mr. Caudill also explained the RS Level of Service Rankings, Flex Funds Process of Application Guidelines, RS 80/20 Bridge Process Application Guidelines, Emergency Funding, Emergency Process: TC 20-16 Application Guidelines, Discretionary Funding (FD39) which is known as the Highway Contingency Account and is administered by the Department of Rural and Municipal Aid.








Chairman Kenneth Catron, Mayor City of Monticello called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. in-person as well as via Zoom conference with 33 persons attending. Chairman Catron welcomed everyone then turned then asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the December 1, 2022 meeting. Motion to approve the minutes was made by Judge Frank. Seconded by Ms. Judy Price. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Chairman Catron ask if there were any nominations for RTC Vice-Chairman. Mr. Randy Marcum, Russell County Judge-Executive was nominated. Ms. Fara Miniard made a motion to approve the nomination of Mr. Randy Marcum as RTC Vice-Chairman. Seconded by Judge Todd . All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Mr. Cole then spoke on the SHIFT County Project Sponsorship Selection stating that he had met with all the local county Judges and Mayors for the SHIFT process with the help of District 4 and District 8. Mr. Cole showed a PowerPoint presentation of each county showing what projects would be selected to get at SHIFT score. Mr. Cole also stated that in the fall projects will be selected to see which ones the Committee will boost.

Mr. Cole then turned the meeting over to Mr. Brad Bottoms, Department of Highways District 4. Mr. Bottoms gave project status updates for Green and Taylor Counties. Mr. Bottoms also discussed projects in the construction phase as well as project completion dates. With no questions or comments Mr. Cole turned the meeting over to Mr. Jeff Dick, Department of Highways District 8.

Mr. Dick gave project status updates for Adair, Casey, Clinton, Cumberland, McCreary, Pulaski, Russell, and Wayne Counties. Mr. Dick also discussed Future Lettings (Proposed Dates), Projects in Design Status, Ongoing Construction Status, FD05 (MP) Resurfacing Project, HSIP (Highway Safety Improvement Program) – Project (Federal funding safety projects) as well as projects completed.

Mr. Cole introduced the Guest Speaker, Ms. Boday Borres, FHWA KY Deputy Division Administrator along with Mr. John Ballantyne, FHWA and Ms. Tonya Higdon, FHWA. Ms. Borres gave a very informative PowerPoint presentation speaking on things such as Bridge Formula Program, Bridge Investment Program, Carbon Reduction Program, Project Grants (formula and discretionary), National Electric Vehicle Formula Program, Highway Safety Improvement Program, Safe Streets and Roads for All, Other Safety-related Provisions, Reconnecting Communities Pilot Program, Rural surface Transportation Grants, Changes to Emergency Relief Program as well as deadlines for Notice of Funding Opportunity.

Mr. Cole then stated that we did get the grant for funding to create a blanket Safety Action Plan for our counties that will cover and highlight areas that need attention across our roadways in our district. Once plan is created counties and cities in our district can utilize the plan to go for Implementation Grants in the range of \$5,000,000 to 30,000,000 to fix any issues that may need to be fixed with our district's roadways.
