Mr. John Frank, Green County Judge-Executive called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. in-person as well as via Zoom conference with 18 persons attending. Judge Frank welcomed everyone then turned then asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the September 8, 2022 meeting. Motion to approve the minutes was made by Judge Green, Seconded by Ms. Judy Price. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Judge Frank then introduced Mr. Adam Kirk, Research Engineer with Kentucky Transportation Center. Mr. Kirk presented a presentation for the Safe Streets for All Grant Application. Mr. Kirk stated that the LCADD grant application was submitted, which included all of the LCADD region. This application will support development of any safety action plan. The plan can be used to pursue any addition funding from the USDT over the next five (5) years. Mr. Kirk also discussed Action Plan Grants, Implementation Grants, Crash History for city, county, and state roadways in the LCADD Region over a five (5) year period 2016-2021, Potential Improvements, Focusing on Systemic region-wide safety improvements, Improved Signing, Improved Data Collection and Analysis Efforts, Implement Asset Management Platform for each local agency, Policy Improvements, Individual Agencies Identify High Value of Local Project, Requirements for the Safety Action Plan. Mr. Ian Cole, LCADD Transportation Planner thanked Mr. Kirk for the very informative presentation.

Mr. Cole then turned the meeting over to Mr. Kevin Young, Department of Highways District 4. Mr. Young gave project status updates for Green and Taylor Counties. Mr. Young also discussed projects in the construction phase as well as project completion dates. With no questions or comments Mr. Cole turned the meeting over to Mr. Jeff Dick, Department of Highways District 8.

Mr. Dick gave project status updates for Adair, Casey, Clinton, Cumberland, McCreary, Pulaski, Russell, and Wayne Counties. Mr. Dick also discussed Future Lettings (Proposed Dates), Projects in Design Status, Ongoing Construction Status, FD05 (MP) Resurfacing Project, HSIP (Highway Safety Improvement Program) – Project (Federal funding safety projects) as well as projects completed.

In other business, Mr. Cole stated that Ms. Whitney Frost, LCADD GIS Specialist put together KIA Mapbooks for anyone that was interested in one. Mr. Cole also commented on the US-127 Socioeconomic Study that will be included in the Corridor Planning Study for KYTC. The corridor is a portion of US-127 form just outside of Liberty city limits to the northern Lincoln County line, just before Junction City. Demographic data will be used from census block shapefiles to show the effect of the project on the communities surrounding the corridor. There will be graphically created via-ArcMap, and include analytical data in paragraph form. Also, the FY 2023 SHIFT (Strategic Highway Investment Formula for Tomorrow) project prioritization will start in the beginning of the year, as well as individual meetings to discuss CHAF selection and scoring. This will include

LCADD staff, KYTC District 4 and 8 engineers, and local Judge Executives and Mayors.

With no further questions or comments, Mr. Cole thanked everyone that came in-person as well as those who joined in on Zoom.
