Transportation Committee Meeting  
Thursday, October 1, 2020 @ 10:00 a.m. Central Time**

**MEETING MINUTES**

Chairman Billy Guffey, Mayor of Burkesville called the meeting to order at 10:02 a.m. in the Large Conference Room of the Lake Cumberland Area Development District in Russell Springs, Kentucky via Zoom conference due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic with 15 persons attending. Chairman Guffey welcomed everyone then turned the meeting over to Mr. Kevin Young, Department of Highways District 4.

Mr. Young gave project status updates for Green and Taylor Counties. Mr. Young also discussed projects in the construction phase as well as projects completed. With no questions or comments Chairman Guffey turned the meeting over to Mr. Jeff Dick, Department of Highways District 8.

Mr. Dick gave project status updates for Adair, Casey, Clinton, Cumberland, McCreary, Pulaski, Russell, and Wayne Counties. Mr. Dick also discussed Future Lettings (Proposed Dates), Projects in Design Status, Ongoing Construction Status, FD05 (MP) Resurfacing Project, HSIP (Highway Safety Improvement Program) – Project (Federal funding safety projects) as well as projects completed.

Next Chairman Guffey ask Ms. Kasey Hoskins to discuss LCADD RTC Goals & Objectives Review. Ms. Hoskins stated that the Goals & Objectives are turned into the State every October with any changes that may be made. With the Goals & Objectives being reviewed there were no changes made to the written portion, but there were some format changes. With there being no changes made to the written portion then there did not have to be a vote or any motions made concerning this matter.

Ms. Hoskins went on to discuss changes or updates that needed to be made to the LCADD RTC Bylaws Amendments. Ms. Hoskins stated one of the things that she wanted to change in the Bylaws was for the Transportation Committee to be able to have virtual meetings via Zoom due to the ongoing conditions of the COVID-19 pandemic. Ms. Hoskins stated that that the Section that is up for approval to be added into the Bylaws is Section 4 under Article IV titled “Meetings,” This section will be a completely new addition stating: In the event that it is unsafe to meet in person, both regular and special meetings may be held virtually via video or teleconferencing or other ADD-approved virtual meeting service where all members can be seen and heard. The necessity of holding a virtual meeting will be decided on by the LCADD Executive Director and care should be taken to ensure all members and public participants have access to

these meetings. With no questions or comments, Chairman Guffey entertained a motion to except the amendment change. Motion was made by Ms. Judy Price. Seconded by Mr. Gary Robertson. All in favor. Motion Carried.

Next Chairman Guffey introduced Mr. Kenny Morgan, Field Representative with Kentucky Transportation Cabinet. Mr. Morgan commented that he has reached out to some committee members but has not been able to see anybody due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Mr. Morgan stated that all of the projects that the rural roads and municipal aid are doing are still out there. Mr. Morgan went on to discussed Flex Money, Emergency Funds and Contingency Funds. Mr. Morgan then gave out his contact information in the event that anyone should have any further question or concerns. With no comments or discussion, Chairman Guffey thanked Mr. Morgan for attending the meeting.

Next Mr. Neal Cundiff, Director of Planning with the Lake Cumberland Area Development District gave Local Road Updates. Mr. Cundiff stated that in 2019 LCADD Planning staff begin visiting counties and cities with a road/street list of all roads and streets that have been mapped and checking to see if the county roads and city streets have the correct road/street names. If any changes need to be made then there will be a resolution sent from the state that will go before the fiscal court or city council to be voted on so that the corrections can be added. Mr. Cundiff stated that this will continue until 2021, but at this time the LCADD Staff is not going out and mapping roads due to the COVID-19 pandemic restrictions.

In Other Business, Ms. Kasey Hoskins stated that she has received an email from Ms. Shirley Cummins at RTEC stating that previously Mr. Tyler Burriss has been our voting member for Public Transit, but currently Mr. Burriss has changed positions so Ms. Cummins would like to put in Ms. Anne Weber as a representative for the Public Transit voting member. Ms. Weber is another employee at RTEC that would be able to attend the Transportation meetings and have a voice in the public transit position as well as have the information in our area for public transit. Mr. Gary Robertson made a motion to change the Public Transit voting member from Tyler Burriss to Anne Weber. Seconded by Ms. Judy Price. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Ms. Hoskins commented that she will soon be scheduling SHIFT meetings with the counties, cities and highway district staff to go over roads in your area to check for any road issues or to go over any projects that are on the list or any that may not be on the list. The next cycle of SHIFT will be starting up soon and running through February. These meeting will most likely be through Zoom.

Ms. Hoskins stated that another thing to be on the look-out for will be the Rural Conservation Survey. This is a federal mandated requirement to get feed-back on how our transportation process works in our area and to see if the transportation committee feels that LCADD

Transportation department is meeting the needs of the committee. This will be a 24 question survey. The State will be sending out the link for the survey on or around October 15<sup>th</sup> via email as well as a post card by mail.

With there being no other business Chairman Guffey thanked everybody for attending the virtual meeting. Meeting adjourned at 10:42 a.m. Central Time.

Wider distribution of the minutes may be made as deemed necessary by the Chairman of the Transportation Committee.

The necessity of holding a virtual meeting will be decided on by the LCADD Executive Director and care should be taken to ensure all members and public participants have access to these meetings.
