Seconded by Judge-Executive Ricky Craig. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Judge Marcum then turned the meeting over to Mr. Kevin Young, Department of Highways District 4. Mr. Young gave project status updates for Green and Taylor Counties. Mr. Young also discussed projects in the construction phase as well as project completion dates. Mr. Troy Hearn, Active Living Program Coordinator with the Kentucky Department for Public Health gave a very informative PowerPoint Presentation over Bicycle Pedestrian Plan Initiatives.

- Public ride facility documentation for KYTC was done in the month of April 2024 to see if there were any areas in our district that we need to promote the public ride facilities.
- Mr. Cole will be doing the Major Freight Users Inventory during this coming deliverable cycle. This inventory documents any facilities with 100 or more trucks per day, 5 truck bays, or 100,000 square foot new distribution space.
- Mr. Cole attended a Safe Streets for All training in Elizabethtown with Mr. Adam Kirk, Transportation Cabinet Safety Circuit Writer. Documentation with our Safety Action Plan will begin within the next few weeks. Those documentations will go into our Safety Action Plan.
- Please contact Mr. Cole as he is currently doing the GIS work here at the ADD for anyone that may have any local road updates or any issues.
- Nominations will be taken for the positions of the Public Citizen at Large for our community and for Economic Development. Any nominations will be put on the next meeting agenda and brought forth to the committee to be voted on and approved.
