

Lake Cumberland ADD Regional Transportation Committee
Thursday, December 4th, 2025 @ 12:00 Central Time
Meeting Minutes DRAFT

Chairman Dennis Benningfield, Mayor of the City of Campbellsville, called the meeting to order at 12:00 a.m. in-person as well as via Zoom conference with 26 persons attending. Chairman Benningfield welcomed everyone then asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the August, 2025 meeting. Motion to approve the minutes was made by Judge Executive of Adair County Larry Russell Bryant. Seconded by Deputy Judge Executive of Russell County Susan Melton. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Chairman Benningfield then turned the meeting over to Mr. Kevin Young, Department of Highways District 4. Mr. Young gave project status updates for Green and Taylor Counties. Mr. Young also discussed projects in the construction phase, as well as, project completion dates. With no questions or comments, Chairman Benningfield thanked Mr. Young and turned the meeting over to Mr. Jeff Dick, Department of Highways District 8.

Mr. Dick gave project status updates for Adair, Casey, Clinton, Cumberland, McCreary, Pulaski, Russell, and Wayne Counties. Mr. Dick also discussed Future Lettings (Proposed Dates), Projects in Design Status, Ongoing Construction Status, HSIP (Highway Safety Improvement Program) – Project (Federal funding safety projects), as well as, projects completed.

Chairman Benningfield then turned the meeting over to Mr. Troy Hearn of the Kentucky Department of Public Health to speak on the SPAN program, which seeks to help rural communities develop Bike and Pedestrian Plans.

Chairman Benningfield then turned the meeting over to Ms. Leslie Lester from LCADD to speak on the Safe Streets 4 All program, for which LCADD has received funding. Ms. Lester informed the meeting of the funding opportunities and methodologies of local governments taking control of their county's share of the program.

Next, Chairman Benningfield turned the meeting over to Mr. Hayden Hancock for other business. Mr. Hancock introduced the need for an updated roster of committee members and provided the committee with a chance to suggest additions and changes to be finalized next meeting. Next, Mr. Hancock reviewed the CHAF and SHIFT processes as well as the TAP program. Mr. Hancock also reported on the KYTC data needed before the next transportation committee in March 2026, including Rail Freight Loading and Unloading Facilities as well as Major Freight Users.

Chairman Benningfield asked for a motion to adjourn at 1:12. Motion made by Judge Executive of McCreary County Jimmie Greene. Seconded by Eric Wolford from Russell County Schools. All in Favor. Motion Carried.
