Meeting Minutes DRAFT

Chairman Eddie Thomas, Mayor of the City of Russell Springs, called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. in-person as well as via Zoom conference with 20 persons attending. Chairman Thomas welcomed everyone then asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the June 2026 meeting. Motion to approve the minutes was made by Mayor Robert Lawson of Burnside. Seconded by Eric Wolford from Russell County Schools. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Chairman Thomas then turned the meeting over to Mr. Kevin Young, Department of Highways District 4. Mr. Young gave project status updates for Green and Taylor Counties. Mr. Young also discussed projects in the construction phase, as well as, project completion dates. With no questions or comments, Chairman Thomas thanked Mr. Young and turned the meeting over to Mr. Hayden Hancock standing in for Mr. Jeff Dick, KYTC Department of Highways District 8.

Mr. Hancock gave project status updates for Adair, Casey, Clinton, Cumberland, McCreary, Pulaski, Russell, and Wayne Counties. Mr. Hancock also discussed Future Lettings (Proposed Dates), Projects in Design Status, Ongoing Construction Status, HSIP (Highway Safety Improvement Program) – Project (Federal funding safety projects), as well as, projects completed.

Mr. Hancock continued to lead the meeting in reviewing the Committee Bylaws. Mr. Hancock proposed changes to the bylaws including an addition requiring a period in meetings for members in the meeting to speak about transportation related topics. Motion to approve the updated Bylaws was made by Judge Jimmie Greene of McCreary County. Seconded Mayor Robert Lawson of Burnside. All in Favor. Motion Carried. Mr. Hancock then led the meeting in reviewing the Committee Goals and Objectives. Mr. Hancock proposed changes including adding CHAF and SHIFT to the committee's objectives. Motion to approve the updated Goals and Objectives was made by Judge Randy Marcum of Russell County. Seconded by Judge Jimmie Greene of McCreary County. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Next, Mr. Hancock discussed other business. Mr. Hancock discussed the Public Involvement Plan, the Regional Transportation Asset Inventory, 2026 Enacted Highway Plan, STIP, the KY-461 Study, and recently developed Bike and Pedestrian Plans.

Chairman Thomas asked for a motion to adjourn at 12:28 p.m. Motion made by Judge Randy Marcum of Russell County. Seconded by Judge Jimmie Greene of McCreary County. All in Favor. Motion Carried.
